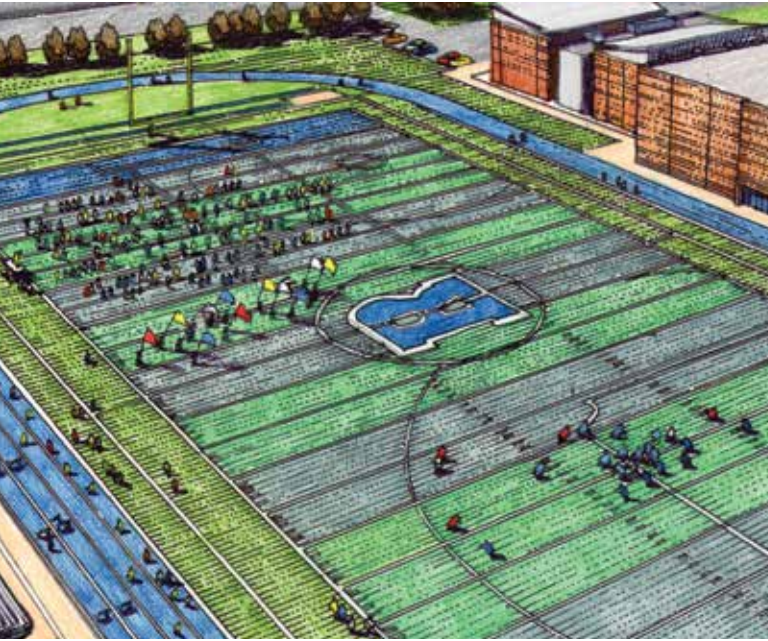


ROOSEVELT *for Generations*

MULTI-PURPOSE FIELD

The track and field are utilized heavily for physical education classes; marching band practices; and football, soccer and track and field teams.

The new track and field will include:

- † Synthetic turf field
- † Track reconstruction and surfacing
- † Fencing, sidewalks and signage
- † Landscaping and beautification

A LIBRARY REIMAGINED

The library will be transformed into a 21st century Innovation and Learning Center that will include:

- † Flexible spaces to foster small group projects, collaboration and critical thinking
- † Full range of essential connectivity, technologies and presentation tools
- † A vibrant hub with infrastructure and resources to support 21st century learning



WHY IS PRIVATE SUPPORT NEEDED?

Raising private dollars in support of a public school typically raises this question:

Why do I need to donate when I pay taxes to support our schools? The answer is simple and yet complex.

While Roosevelt continues to deliver an exceptional educational and extracurricular experience, the ability to enhance Roosevelt's

physical environment and compete with suburban schools who have new facilities is difficult.

It is important to note that these capital projects are a collaborative effort with Des Moines Public Schools. Financial support will be received from the restricted DMPS capital improvement fund as well as private fundraising.
